## Meal Plans

In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the 2009-2010 academic year. You may choose whichever plan best meets your dining needs. The dining plans allow students access to the Caf. Meal plans that include Flex Dollars can be used in the Sac and the Caf. All meal plans may be used only by the cardholder.

### Platinum

\$850/semester - 19 Meals - Allows you access to all 19 meals available at the Caf in Kellogg Hall every week, plus two Wolves Passes.

### Platinum Flex

\$850/semester - 15 meals plus \$150 - Allows you access to 15 of the 19 meals available at the Caf in Kellogg Hall, \$150 that can be used in the SAC, and two Wolves Passes.

### Gold

\$750/semester - 15 Meals - Allows you access to 15 of the 19 meals available at the Caf in Kellogg Hall every week, plus two Wolves Passes.

### Gold Flex

\$750/semester - 12 Meals plus \$100 - Allows you access to 12 of the 19 meals available at the Caf in Kellogg Hall, \$100 that can be used in the SAC, and two Wolves Passes.

### Silver

\$650/semester - 8 Meals - Allows you access to 8 of the 19 meals available at the Caf in Kellogg Hall every week, plus two Wolves Passes.

### Silver Flex

\$650/semester - 6 Meals plus \$75 - Allows you access to 6 of the 19 meals available at the Caf in Kellogg Hall. \$75 that can be used in the SAC, and two Wolves Passes.



## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q: Do I need to purchase a meal plan?**

A: Yes! It's a great value and it is Walla Walla University's policy that all designated Campus Residents purchase a meal plan each quarter.

**Q: What are Flex Dollars?**

A: Flex Dollars are cash values included in some meal plans. They work like a pre-paid debit card with funds kept on your student ID card. Flex Dollars may be used at any on-campus dining location.

**Q: Do Flex Dollars carry over from quarter to quarter?**

A: They are a part of your meal plan for that quarter and should be used during that time. They are not carried over from quarter to quarter.

**Q: Do missed meals carry over from week to week?**

A: Meals should be used during the current week and do not carry over from week to week.

**Q: What is a Wolves Pass?**

A: A Wolves Pass may be used for guests to join the meal plan owner for a meal in the Caf. Each student on a meal plan receives two Wolves Passes per quarter.

**Q: Can I change my meal plan if it does not fit my needs?**

A: Yes! Changing to a bigger or smaller meal plan can be done during the first ten days of the school quarter. Changing to a larger plan is possible at any time during the quarter. All other changes must be requested by the VP of Student Life and Missions.

**Q: If I'm not a Resident Hall student, where do I buy my meal plan?**

A: If you live off-campus, you can purchase meal plans at the Campus Services office located on the main floor of Kellogg Hall. Cash and credit cards are accepted as payment.

**Q: What if I want to add to my Flex dollars?**

Flex dollars are a smart and easy way to make purchases at the Campus Services office. The program works like a pre-paid debit card and balances carry over from year to year. For more information on this great deal, call us at (509) 527-2732.

## Where to Dine at Walla Walla University

**The Caf-** The dining hall is located on the main level in Kellogg Hall and offers a variety of all-you-care-to-eat options. Some of your choices include:

**Classics:** traditional comfort foods including casseroles and fresh steamed or sautéed vegetables just like mom makes...for 700

**Pizza-rette:** fresh made pizzas daily with favorite toppings like Five Cheeses and Grilled Vegetables

**Flash in the Pan:** where our chefs prepare some of your favorites including Raviolis with Marinara, Vegetable Stir Fry and Penne Pasta ala Pesto

**Gifts from the Garden:** our Salad Bar compares to no other in College Place with fresh local produce, legumes, grains, fruits and homemade composed salads

**Sandwiches and Wraps:** daily specials that are made-to-order with creations like BLT's with Avocado, Buffalo Chicken Wraps with a Chipotle sauce or an Over-stuffed Pita with Hummus
